Endocrine disorders are commonly diagnosed via a combination of clinical evaluation of symptoms and medical history, blood tests, and in some cases, imaging tests, and biopsies. Typically, endocrine disorders cause a deficiency or excess of hormone, so testing for the presence or lack of sufficient hormones, and the body's ability to produce ...

Endocrine Diseases Your endocrine system includes eight major glands throughout your body, such as the thyroid gland, pituitary gland, adrenal gland, and pancreas. This system affects growth and development, metabolism, sexual function, and mood. If your hormone levels are too high or too low, you may have an endocrine disease or disorder.

Many of the hormones produced by the pituitary regulate the function of other endocrine glands, such as a thyroid, adrenals and the gonads. Some examples of pituitary hormones and associated diseases include: -- Antidiuretic hormone, or ADH, governs body fluid levels.

Endocrine emergencies. In endocrinology, medical emergencies include diabetic ketoacidosis, hyperosmolar hyperglycemic state, hypoglycemic coma, acute adrenocortical insufficiency, pheochromocytoma crisis, hypercalcemic crisis, thyroid storm, myxoedema coma and pituitary apoplexy.

The most common endocrine disorders dealt with today by equine practitioners and owners are pituitary pars intermedia dysfunction (PPID, a.k.a. Cushing's Syndrome) and equine metabolic syndrome (EMS). In general, the endocrine system is composed of several organs which produce hormones that control many body functions.

Depending on the type of cell they originate in, tumors can produce excess hormones or destroy normal glandular tissue, decreasing hormone production.
